## Why our remote virtual internship program?

**I believe that it is very important to have an internship on your CV and to be able to showcase the skills that you have developed.** When I heard about the programs offered by The Intern Group, I decided that this was what I wanted to do.

## Did you have any doubts about our remote internship program?

## What do you think are the greatest **benefits** of an international internship program?

One of the greatest benefits is that **I now have the ability to work remotely using different platforms**, which is a great advantage in today's workplace and which I have highlighted on my CV. Another great benefit was that I gained work experience with a global company.

One of the greatest benefits was that having interns in locations where we do not have employees **helped us reach out to people that we would not normally be able to reach** due to the time difference.

## What **impact** did our internship have on you?

**Working in different departments made me realize how a business functions** at different levels and how I like to be involved in all of them and not necessarily just one.

**The impact was huge** not only because of the work they provided but also due to the insights they brought. What is more, the fact that we had interns in different time zones, had a positive impact on our relationships with our clientele.

## Would you **recommend** The Intern Group's internship program?

For people who don't know which career path to follow, **an internship is a great way to explore the world and get a better understanding of what career path you want to follow.**

**Absolutely!** I cannot stress enough that the interns that we get are willing to work and to put in the time and effort.
