Placement in a professional internship

- Global Internship Program: The student is placed in a host company located in one of our global program destinations.
- Digital Nomad Program: The student travels to a program destination and interns remotely for a host company which may be located anywhere in the world, experiencing both in-person cultural immersion and modern online collaboration.
- Virtual Program: The student is placed in a fully remote role in a host company which may be located anywhere.

Academic credit

Optional transfer credit from our School of Record, Florida A&M University.

Housing

Student accommodation facilities with a private bedroom (no bunk beds or home stays), in a convenient location within the destination city.

Mental health support

Free, confidential, 24/7 access to mental health services provided by licensed professionals.

DISC assessment

Professional DISC assessment of the student's workplace behavior profile.

Visa support

Step-by-step guidance provided by a dedicated visa team.

Airport pickup

Airport pickup and transfer to the program housing.

- All of the features listed above are included in the program fee. Airfare, food, insurance, and external visa fees are not included.
- The admissions process includes a clear discussion and explanation of the program fees, which are also listed in detail on our website.
- The Intern Group contributes matching financial aid of US\$500 for students who are beneficiaries of a Pell Grant (USA) or of certain government aid programs in Canada, the UK, Hong Kong, Australia, and New Zealand.



HEALTH & SAFETY

- Unlimited, confidential access to online professional mental health services for three months during the program.
- Airport pickup, orientation, vetted housing, and 24/7 emergency support.
- Ongoing monitoring of travel warnings and advice issued by the US State Department and the UK Foreign Office, as well as our own staff on the ground in the destinations.
- Suitable travel & medical insurance is mandatory for all participants who are on a travel program. If the student's home institution or another party does not provide such insurance, then the student will be referred to a specialist provider of insurance for study-abroad participants.
